**URBAN AGRICULTURE QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE**

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<b>FEATURES</b>	<b>URBAN GARDEN</b>	<b>MARKET GARDEN</b>
<b>Purpose:</b>	Beautification, education, recreation, community use, or consumption.	Community Supported Agriculture (CSA), or on-site sales.
<b>Sales:</b>	NO ON-SITE SALES ALLOWED -Off-site sales or off-site donations are permitted only.	Sales are permitted. All products sold on-site must be grown on-site.
<b>Residentially Zoned Districts:</b>	Permitted as a principal use on undeveloped lots by Special Administrative Permit (SAP) <sup>1</sup> . Permitted as an accessory use to any dwelling that serves as a permitted principal use.	Permitted as an accessory use on certain institutional use lots.
<b>Non-residentially Zoned Districts:</b>	Permitted as a principal or accessory use without an SAP.	Permitted as a principal or accessory use.
<b>Parking Requirements:</b>	None.	In zoning districts with no minimum parking requirements, no parking is required. In all other districts a minimum of 3 spaces must be provided: 2 spaces for customers, and 1 space for garden personnel <sup>2</sup> .
<b>Sales Hours:</b>	N/A	From 7 am until 9 pm. CSA pick-ups are allowed at any time during the sales hours.
