


CITY OF ATLANTA - NPU W: 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) W is 19,286, a decrease of 768 (4%) from a 2000 population of 20,054.


The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU W. NPU W has an overall density of 5.7 persons per acre.



AGE




The median age of the population is 34.8. 18% of the population is under 18, 7% of the population is over 65 and 44% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.






RACE




The racial composition of NPU W is 55% White, 38% Black, 2% Asian, and 6% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, other and two or more races). Six percent of the population is of Hispanic or Latin Origin.



In 2000, the racial composition of NPU W was 36% percent White, 58% Black, 5% Asian and 5% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and Other). Six percent of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.



HOUSEHOLDS




There are 19,043 NPU W residents in 8,786 households. Of these, 46% are family households and 54% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 23% have children under age 18 and 12% have an individual 65 years and older.

Thirty-six percent of households are single person households, with 5% being single person households over 65, 12% are female headed households and 29% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.17 persons per household and the average family size is 2.94 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 7,958 households in NPU W, 29% of households had children under age 18 and 30% were single person households. The average household size was 2.47 persons per household.


2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU W




Ninety-nine percent of the NPU W population is in households and 1% (243) live in group quarters.



HOUSING



NPU W has 9,989 housing units, an increase of 1,502 (18%) housing units from 8,487 in 2000. 88% are occupied and 12% are vacant. Rental units have 13% vacancy rate while owner occupied units have a 5% vacancy rate.
