


CITY OF ATLANTA - NPU S: 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) S is 10,063, a decrease of 2,333 (19%) from a 2000 population of 12,396.

The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU S. NPU S has an overall density of 4.1 persons per acre.




The median age of the population is 37. Twenty-six percent of the population is under 18, 14% of the population is over 65 and 25% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.




In 2000, NPU S had a median age of 35.1. Ten percent of the population was over 65 and 27% of the population was between 20 and 39 years old.



RACE






In 2000, the racial composition of NPU S was 96% Black, 3% White, 0% Asian and 1% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and Other). One percent of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.

HOUSEHOLDS




There are 9,965 NPU S residents in 3,621 households. Of these, 66% are family households and 34% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 32% have children under age 18 and 30% have an individual 65 years and older.

Twenty-seven percent of households are single person households, with 10% being single person households over 65, 37% are female headed households and 21% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.75 persons per household and the average family size is 3.37 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 4,335 households in NPU S, 39% of households had children under age 18 and 26% were single person. The average household size was 2.81 persons per household.


2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU S



Ninety-nine of NPU S's population is in households. The remaining 1% are in group quarters


