



Defensive Driving Course Alive at 25®

Since 1995, more than 750,000 young adults have learned life-saving defensive driving skills from Alive at 25 training. It addresses the number one cause of death for drivers ages 15 to 24 — motor vehicle crashes — and has been adopted by many states and courts for graduated licensing and traffic violator programs. Alive at 25 is a highly-effective four-hour course that serves as an excellent complement to standard driver education programs — and is also ideal for young drivers who incur traffic violations. Through interactive media segments, workbook exercises, class discussions & role playing, young drivers develop convictions and strategies that will keep them safe on the road.

TRAVELING ON I-85 NORTH

- Exit Indian Trail Lilburn Rd (exit #101)
- Turn left on Indian Trail Lilburn Rd crossing over the expressway.
- Go to 1st light at Waffle House
- Turn left onto Brook Hollow Pkwy.
- Turn immediate right into Indian Trail Center.
- Building 5161 with NSC logo.
- Parking in front and rear.
- Follow signs to NSC classrooms.

TRAVELING ON I-85 SOUTH

- Exit Indian Trail Lilburn Rd (exit #101)
- At the light, continue straight across Indian Trail Lilburn Rd onto Brook Hollow Pkwy.
- After Chevron Station, turn immediate right into Indian Trail Center.
- Building 5161 with NSC logo.
- Parking in front and rear.
- Follow signs to NSC classrooms.
