

Campaign Contribution Disclosure Report Filing Procedures

1) Candidates who have received or spent \$10,000 or more in an election cycle (defined as the day following the last election for the particular office through the day of the next election) are required to electronically file a State of Georgia Campaign Contribution Disclosure Report with the Municipal Clerk on designated dates. Non-candidate campaign committees, PACs, etc. that support a candidate must generally file the Campaign Contribution Disclosure Report on the same basis as the candidate they are supporting files.

2) Candidates who do not meet the electronic filing requirement are encouraged to file electronically but may choose instead to file a signed and notarized hard-copy Campaign Contribution Disclosure Report with the Municipal Clerk that is delivered or post-marked by the U.S. Postal Service on designated dates.
