**American Recovery and Re-Investment Act
Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing**

SUMMARY

The **Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Fund** will provide financial assistance and services to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless and help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized. The funds under this program are intended to target individuals and families who would be homeless but for this assistance.

Homelessness Prevention: Rental Assistance & Utility Assistance

Rapid Re-Housing: Relocating to permanent housing

CLIENT ELIGIBILITY

A person's or family's eligibility for HPRP assistance is based on 4 conditions:

- 1) Must be city of Atlanta residents
- 2) Each client must have an initial assessment by a case manager.
- 3) The case manager's assessment must show that the person or family would become, or would continue to be, literally homeless without the HPRP assistance.
- 4) The total household income, counting income from all members of the household, cannot be more than 50% of the Atlanta area median income, as shown below:
