

Christmas Tree Recycling Site Information

On January 8th, remove all of the decorations from your Christmas tree (ornaments, tinsel etc.) and take your tree to the drop off site. Your tree will be chipped into mulch or used as wildlife habitat. Either way, you'll help keep your tree out of the landfill and put it to good use. You will also receive a free seedling for as long as supplies last and in some communities, free mulch is also available.

Please be sure to remove stands, lights and all other decorations. Seedlings will be given away at this time at participating sites and while supplies last. Your community may also be offering additional times and locations for Christmas tree recycling.
