

THE ADOPT A SPOT/ STREET PROGRAM REQUIRES A ONE YEAR COMMITMENT

*All individuals and groups are expected to make a commitment for a minimum of 1 year. Your group is asked to remove litter & maintain your adopted area **MONTHLY** and/or as needed.*

Volunteers are specifically encouraged to work as part of a recognizable group (family, business, church, club, civic, etc.) and to take appropriate measures to contain, store and dispose of all litter, debris, yard trimming collected during any clean-up event.

Adopt a Spot

The City of Atlanta Department of Public Works (DPW) is seeking community partners to lend a hand in keeping public spaces clean.

The Adopt A Spot/Street program allows individuals, community groups, associations, and others to agree to maintain a public space for up to one year. Adopted spaces may be renewed upon request.

Adopting individuals/organizations are required to complete an application nominating the spot they wish to adopt.

All program requirements are strictly enforced. Please inform DPW if you and/or your group are unable to keep your adoption commitment. If so, your spot will become eligible for someone else to adopt.

Areas are checked regularly by Public Works staff. You will be notified if problems develop in your adopted area.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Select a public area that has a clearly identifiable need for litter reduction
- Submit an adoption application
- Sign a liability waiver
- Attend safety training
- Maintain adopted spot for one year

Note: Volunteers under the age of 15 require adult applicant signature and supervision during all

SUPPLIES & TRAINING



Volunteers receive safety vests, disposable gloves, and garbage bags. These items will be offered on a one time basis at the time of approved adoption.

All volunteers will be required to attend DPW Safety Training. This one hour session must be conducted prior to being assigned a spot/street.
