



CARGO ATLANTA: A Citywide Freight Study

A supplement to the *Connect Atlanta Plan*

Overview

The **Cargo Atlanta Study** is a comprehensive freight study that will explore the importance of all modes of freight in the City of Atlanta and develops policies, programs, and projects that will help improve freight movements through the city while balancing the needs of communities connected to freight uses.

The freight assessment report will detail the current state of freight and goods movement within the city, its importance to the city's economy, and identify key issues and opportunities that will aid in identifying potential capital improvements to address freight movements.

Study Goal: Develop solutions to better accommodate the needs of the freight industry in the city while adapting to the changing neighborhood dynamics transforming Atlanta.

Study Objectives:

- Detail the current state of freight and goods movement within the city and its importance
- Identify the strengths, opportunities, and challenges facing
 - ⇒ the movers of freight
 - ⇒ the communities served by freight
 - ⇒ the neighborhoods connected to freight
- Develop policies, programs and projects that will benefit those groups.
