The *AWDA Career Coach* is a state-of-the-art mobile career unit created to help the Atlanta Workforce Development Agency (AWDA) access underserved populations in the City of Atlanta.

The *Career Coach*, which is deployed to high unemployment areas where residents also lack access to transportation, adds value to City of Atlanta residents. It allows residents who do not have access to the City's workforce services the ability to:


- Register for Workforce Investment Act grants
- Receive job training
- Receive job placement assistance
- Attend resume workshops
- Take various classes such as computer skills, interviewing skills, and re-entry
- Receive testing for literacy and numeracy
