City of Atlanta Announces New Year's Day Solid Waste Collection Schedule

Customers Encouraged to Recycle Christmas Trees during January 5 Tree Recycling Event

ATLANTA – The City of Atlanta Department of Public Works reminds residential customers that all garbage, recycling and yard waste will not be collected on New Year's Day, Tuesday, January 1, 2019. All curbside collection services will be delayed one day the remainder of the week. If Friday is a customer's normal collection day, all refuse and yard waste will be collected Saturday, January 5.

Customers are encouraged to recycle their Christmas trees on Saturday, January 5 from 9 a.m.- 4 p.m. during the Bring One for the Chipper Christmas tree recycling event at participating Home Depot stores and at the Center for Hard to Recycle Materials (CHaRM).
