The City of Atlanta's Department of Procurement ("DOP") on behalf of [Department of Watershed Management] is seeking [a qualified contractor to perform on-call electrical testing and inspection services to inspect, test and/or calibrate electrical equipment at the Water and Wastewater Treatment Facilities. Facilities include two (2) water treatment plants, four (4) water reclamation centers, sixteen (16) Wastewater pump stations, and nine (9) combined sewer overflow facilities. These services shall include short circuit and coordination studies and small adjustments, tightening, and cleaning which is incidental to testing. Examples include service or repair of the following: Specific testing includes high potential testing on cables, relay-testing calibration, insulation power factor testing, control wire function checkout, transformer saturation and polarity testing. In addition, testing and inspection of cabling that connects the switchgear to other electrical circuits.
