Other items included in the scope of work are removal of existing underground storage tank and reprogramming of existing Airfield Lighting Control and Monitoring system. Scope of work shall also include tasks that replace existing lighting isolation transformers, environmental fuel tank demolition, installation of airfield lighting cables, control system modifications, electrical distribution equipment installation and manhole reconfiguration and clean up. The majority of the work will take place on the airfield in an operational environment.
