Empire Boulevard Tactical Walk/Bike Lane

February 2025

Project Description

The City of Atlanta's Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) is partnering with Council Member Antonio Lewis to extend the tactical walk/bike lane installed along Empire Boulevard between Ward Drive and Oak Drive in 2023. Through Safe Routes to School discretionary funds from District 12 and as an initiative to calm traffic and improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists, the lane will continue on Empire Boulevard from Oak Drive through Mt. Zion Road.

This project is also part of the department's Safe Routes to School partnership with Crawford Long Middle School and serves residents in the Glenrose Heights neighborhood. ATLDOT anticipates installing the tactical walk/bike lane in the Spring of 2025.

Location

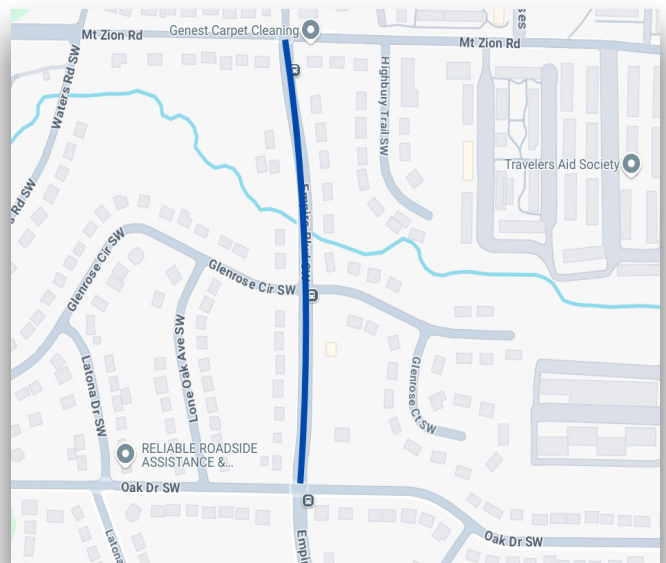
Empire Boulevard between Oak Drive and Mt. Zion Rd.

Project installation is anticipated to be completed in the Spring of 2025.
