Sylvan Road Safety Improvements

December 2025

Project Description

The City of Atlanta’s Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) is partnering with Council Member Antonio Lewis (D-12) to calm traffic and improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists through Safe Routes to School discretionary funds. The project will install bike lane protection along Sylvan Road SW between Dill Avenue SW and Deckner Avenue SW to improve safety and encourage safe driving around Sylvan Hills Middle School. Traffic calming measures such as bulb-outs/curb extensions at the intersection of Dill and Hartford Avenues, as well as speed cushions along Sylvan Road SW between Byron Drive SW and Astor Avenue SW are also included in the project.

Part of ATLDOT’s Safe Routes to School partnership with Sylvan Middle School, the project serves students and residents in Adair Park, Capitol View, and Sylvan Hills neighborhoods. ATLDOT shared the final design for the tactical walk/bike lane at Sylvan Middle School during a community open house on May 22. Installation of the safety improvements is scheduled to begin February 16th.

Location

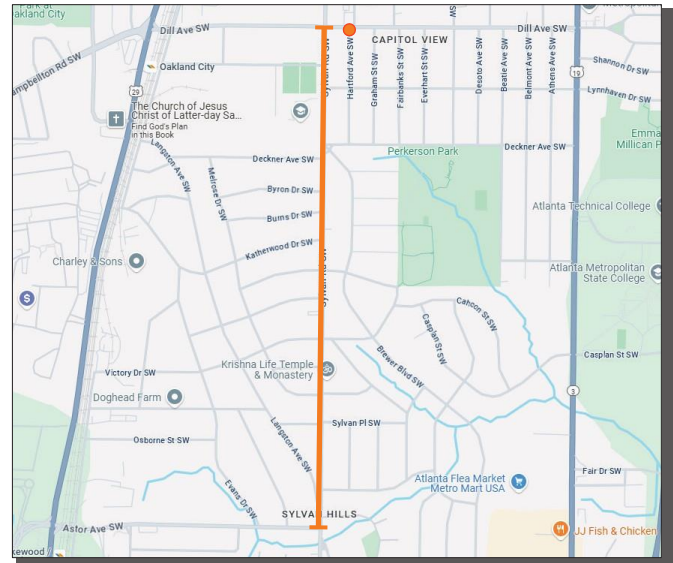
- Sylvan Road SW between Dill Avenue SW and Astor Avenue SW
- Dill Avenue SW at Hartford Avenue SW

Schedule

- Contractor selection process is underway.
- Project installation is scheduled to be completed in February 2026.
