NPU-C VOTING RULES per [2026 Bylaws](#)

Eligible members shall be any person 18 years of age or older whose primary place of residence is within the NPU-C designated area or a representative of any corporation, organization, institution, or agency which owns property or has a place of business or profession within NPU-C designated area (Article II). All eligible members shall have one (1) vote with the exception of NPU officers conducting the meeting, the applicant, those representing the applicant, and those who own more than one percent direct economic interest in the entity. Proxy voting shall not be allowed (Article IV, Sec. 1, 4).



MATTERS FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT

Members can review subdivision applications and provide comments to be forwarded to the Subdivision Review Committee (SRC). Other applications may be presented to an NPU for review and comment when the address is within a 300-foot radius of the NPU's boundary. The Code of Ordinances does not require these applicants to attend NPU meetings.
